

Membership of organizations and groups.

As our constitution states in article 4, section 1:

'Being that we as a body affirm that the Scripture teaches that the only means of salvation that the world has been afforded is in Christ alone through faith alone, membership in a group that holds to teachings contradictory to our doctrinal statement is incompatible with membership in this church.'

By "membership in a group" we mean: to formally covenant with a group through ceremony, rite or promise. Such groups may include organizations who consider themselves religious or non-religious, for example; Roman Catholicism, Mormonism, Jehovah's Witnesses, Church of Christian Science, Free Masonry, Theosophy, Unitarianism, Spiritualism, Scientology, Judaism, Buddhism, Hinduism and Islam. This list is not meant to be exhaustive but illustrative.
