## Warm Up:

When you think of that discouraging issue (or issues) in your life that tends to zap all of your energy, what about it makes it so exhausting and discouraging?

## **Explore:**

Vs 15-17

What is shocking in this section? – And Why?

What do you think it mean's when David's men fear that his death might . . . quench the lamp of Israel?

Why do you think the author includes this War-Log section in his epilogue?

What scriptures can you think of that would encourage us to look beyond David to Jesus for our ultimate King?

(i.e. 2 Samuel 7:10-17 - Isa 11/Romans 15:12 ect)

## Think it Through:

I pointed out in my sermon that because we live this side the arrival of Jesus the ultimate Davidic King, we struggle and fight...:

- 1. From victory not for it. (unlike David's men)
- 2. *In the Light*. (The full Light of Jesus and his Gospel)
- 3. With our King (Not alone as David's men did in their final battles)
