"Ruler over mankind – A righteous one- ruling in the fear of God"

It's a prophetic statement of the future Davidic king to come.

What's the significance of this statement and why does David follow it with these

poetic verses about sun and rain?

Read Vs 5-6

Why this talk about the destiny of worthless men? (see - 20:1)

How can we keep our perspective on our future shaped more by the word of God than by our experience of this world?

Do you ever spend time contemplating the incredible goodness of our Heavenly Kingdom to come as way to lift your spirits?
